May 7: Overnight Flight

We are on our way to Poland, a land of rich culture, astounding history, delicious cuisine, and enduring faith.

May 8: Warsaw

Witamy to Warsaw! We will check into our hotel before celebrating Holy Mass and having an orientation tour of Warsaw's Old Town and Market Square. We will end the evening with an exquisite welcome dinner at one of Warsaw's locally known restaurants.

May 9: Warsaw

We will take you on a half day city tour of Warsaw exploring a special exhibit to Father Jerzy Popieluszko at Saint Stanislaw Kostka Church and the Royal Castle. As we feast at lunch, you will be able to experience a hands-on pierogi making demonstration. Your afternoon is at leisure to explore the alleyways, enjoy a quaint cafe in Warsaw's Old Town, tour a museum, or simply relax.

May 10: Niepokolanow/Lowicz/Czestochowa

We will depart Warsaw and stop to celebrate Holy Mass at Niepokalanow Sanctuary; where Saint Maximilian Maria Raymond Kolbe began his ministry and founded the monthly periodical *Rycerz Niepokalanej (Knight of the Immaculata)*. Following our tour, we will travel to a delightful little town of Lowicz, where Kasia and Wojtek have prepared a meal fit for a king in their elegant castle home. This evening we will transfer to the Hill of Light, Jasna Gora, to say goodnight to Our Lady of Czestochowa and retire at the Arch in Czestochowa.

May 11: Czestochowa/Oswiecim

It is said that Czestochowa is where Poland's heart beats, as the miraculous image of the Black Madonna appears. We will greet our Blessed Mother early this morning with sounds of trumpets, song and prayer, tour the shrine grounds together, and celebrate Holy Mass in this holy monastery where more than 5 million pilgrims journey each year to pay honor to Our Lady of Czestochowa. Following, we will enjoy our afternoon lunch overlooking the Olsztyn castle ruins.

May 12: Oswiecim/Wadowice/Zakopane

Today, we will pilgrimage together through a sad time of history, where a local guide will take us into the former Nazi concentration camp Auschwitz-Birkenau. In the afternoon, we will transfer to Wadowice, where we will enjoy a prepared lunch before touring the birth home of Saint John Paul II. We will celebrate Holy Mass in the parish that SJPII grew up in and received most all of his sacraments. We will continue onward to retire at Radisson Blu Hotel in the lustrous mountains of Zakopane.

May 13: Zakopane

The mountainous region of Poland, Zakopane is home to the highlanders, known for their wooden craftsmanship, artistic window painting, and heavy wool attire. Jaszczurowka Chapel and the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Fatima at Krzeptowki are two of the most must-see attractions, as the handmade beauty surrounds these churches. After visiting these sites, we will walk through the main street of Zakopane to take the funicular to Gubalowka Mountain and enjoy an afternoon at leisure for exploring the city and shopping. In the evening, an exciting, fun-filled dinner awaits us before our overnight at Radisson Blu Hotel, Zakopane.

May 14: Ludzmierz/Zakopane

Today we travel to the iconic Sanctuary of Our Lady of Ludzmierz, where it is revered by the Podhale and Goral people who live in the surrounding Tatra Mountains. Adventure awaits us, as next, we take a river raft ride down the Dunajec River through the Pieniny Gorge, with amazing landscapes and gorgeous views, including the famous Trzy Korony summit range (Three Crowns). The rafts are rowed the old fashioned way, none other than by two Gorale. In the evening, we will return for our overnight at Radisson Blu Hotel, Zakopane.

May 15: Wieliczka/Krakow

Our day will start with a morning transfer to the Salt Mines of Wieliczka. The history of Wieliczka dates back to the Middle Ages. It has been known as the largest source of salt in Poland since the 13th century. We will explore and admire the salt landscapes, salt rocks, lakes, works of art, and celebrate Holy Mass in St. Kinga's Chapel down in the mine. After our time underground, we will have lunch at a local restaurant with evening at leisure. Our overnight accommodations will be at the Holiday Inn, Krakow.

May 16: Krakow

Today we will have the chance to do a half day city tour of Krakow, including stops at the Wawel Cathedral and Old Town. Krakow is known for its well-preserved medieval core and grand historic architecture. You will also have the chance to visit and experience the famous Cloth Hall, which is still used as a center of commerce. If you are looking for souvenirs to bring back, this is a great place to shop! Overnight accommodations will be at the Holiday Inn, Krakow.

May 17: Lagiewniki/Krakow

Today we will visit the original Shrine of Divine Mercy, where Jesus appeared to Sister Maria Faustyna Kowalska and gave her His divine messages of His mercy for the world to know. In the later afternoon, you may enjoy your time at leisure, prior to our farewell dinner together at Miod & Wino Restaurant.



May 18: Chicago

We will enjoy a full morning breakfast to prepare us for our journey back home. We will then be transported to the Balice - Saint John Paul II Airport with flight back to Chicago.
